

Counsellor/Christian Ministry Position for a Couple

Are you wanting a unique, rewarding, stretching, called-to, ministry/professional position?

A couple are required for professional/ministry work in our residential addictions/compulsions programme, and general counselling service.

The counsellor will have counselling qualifications and experience, and be able to competently counsel, facilitate small groups, have leadership skills, and as Programme Manager / Counsellor, be able to cover for the Director from time to time. Specific experience in addiction counselling preferable but not essential.

The other person will be able to perform a variety of caring, ministry, administration, leadership, small group facilitation or other roles, depending on skills / experience, and time available (e.g. family commitments if there are children.)

These are 'live-on' positions, with one position paid (with remuneration made up of salary, accommodation, and power,) and the other voluntary (unpaid).

As a Christian faith-based role, both will be able to express their active Christian faith in their work.

Cross Roads Christian Community Trust has been working from a Christian perspective with people in need since 1993. It is in its 23rd year of operating FreedomLife Te Nikau residential addictions/compulsive behaviours programme and counselling centre, in Paraparaumu on the Kapiti Coast.
